**DRAFT SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT NUMBER 1
TO THE
DISASTER RECOVERY: TORNADOES OF APRIL 2011
ACTION PLAN**

The State of Alabama is substantially amending the HUD-approved Action Plan for Disaster Recovery: Tornadoes of April 2011 to incorporate a correction resulting from a clerical error. The State's approved Action Plan intended and, in fact, indicated that 29 counties would qualify for the "Infrastructure including Public Facilities" assistance. However, the list included only 27 counties. The correct list of 29 counties is as follows:

Bibb, Blount, Calhoun, Cherokee, Choctaw, Colbert, Cullman, DeKalb, Elmore, Etowah, Fayette, Franklin, Hale, Jackson, Jefferson, Lawrence, Limestone, Madison, Marengo, Marion, Marshall, Monroe, Morgan, St. Clair, Sumter, Tallapoosa, Tuscaloosa, Walker, and Winston.
